When considering an IT strategy, businesses have several models from which to choose: on-premises, “Cloud”-based (IT-related services provided over the Internet, also known as software as a service, or SaaS), and a “hybrid” combination. Finding the right solutions to meet business needs gets more complex as the ecosystem of business and technology becomes more diverse.

Prior to investing time and capital in researching an IT strategy, it's crucial to confirm that your IT group is aligned with the business as a whole. Strategic decisions that directly affect IT, but that are made without the input of IT, are guaranteed to be problematic. However, a lack of communication can reach both ways. If IT decides to implement a certain product or service without communicating with the business first, it might find that that decision doesn't support the company's strategic goals. In either case, lack of alignment can result in lost resources, downtime, and antipathy between IT and the business.

Creating an IT strategy and turning it into an actionable plan that maximizes return on investment (ROI) can be very challenging. There is often confusion about what functionality and capabilities to deploy, where to deploy them, how to unlock and

measure the benefits, and how to identify, prioritize, and address the many strategic business processes and IT decisions that will be required.
